

Gradient Scarf

MEASUREMENTS

Scarf Length Approx: 176cm (69 ¼ in)

Scarf Width (unstretched): 16cm (6 ¼ in)

MATERIALS

Knit By Numbers 4 Ply, 100% organically farmed Merino (100m per 25g)

Yarn A: 1 x 25g skein 079

Yarn B: 1 x 25g skein 076

Yarn C: 1 x 25g skein 078

Yarn D: 1 x 25g skein 075

Yarn E: 1 x 25g skein 077

Yarn F: 1 x 25g skein 074

1 pair 2.75mm needles

Embroidery needle for weaving in ends

Note: Yarn amounts given are based on average requirements and are approximate.

TENSION

31 sts and 58 rows to 10cm over garter stitch using 2.75mm needles.

Use larger or smaller needles if necessary to obtain correct tension.

ABBREVIATIONS

st(s) = stitch(es)

sl = slip one stitch knitwise.

wyib = with yarn in back

rep = repeat

RS = right side

WS = wrong side

g-st = garter stitch (knit every row)

SCARF

Using 2.75mm needles and Yarn A, cast on 45 sts.

Rows 1-4: Knit.

Join in Yarn B.

Row 5 (RS): Using Yarn B, wyib, sl1, knit to last st, sl1.

Row 6 (WS): Using Yarn B, wyib, knit.

Row 7: Using Yarn A, wyib, sl1, knit to last st, sl1.

Row 8: Using Yarn A, wyib, knit.

Rep last 4 rows, alternating Yarns A and B every two rows until you have used up both skeins, ending on Yarn B and WS row.

Join in Yarn C.

Next Row (RS): Using Yarn C, wyib, sl1, knit to last st, sl1.

Next Row (WS): Using Yarn C, wyib, knit.

Join in Yarn D.

Next Row (RS): Using Yarn D, wyib, sl1, knit to last st, sl1.

Next Row (WS): Using Yarn D, wyib, knit.

Rep last 4 rows, alternating Yarns C and D every two rows until you have used up both skeins, ending on Yarn D and WS row.

Join in Yarn E.

Next Row (RS): Using Yarn E, wyib, sl1, knit to last st, sl1.

Next Row (WS): Using Yarn E, wyib, knit.

Join in Yarn F.

Next Row (RS): Using Yarn F, wyib, sl1, knit to last st, sl1.

Next Row (WS): Using Yarn F, wyib, knit.

Rep last 4 rows, alternating Yarns E and F every two rows until you have used up both skeins, ending by working 5 rows in g-st of Yarn F, ending on a RS row.

Next row (WS): Cast off Knitwise.

TO MAKE UP

Using an embroidery needle, weave in loose ends.
